A HISTORY OF EASTERN WASHINGTON UNIVERSITY

In 1882, the Benjamin P. Cheney Academy opened its doors to more than 200 enrolling students. A generous contribution of \$10,000 from a wealthy transportation industrialist had at last fulfilled the dreams of Cheney citizens for an institute of higher learning in their community.

The academy became the State Normal School at Cheney in 1889, the same year in which Washington was given its statehood. The school was proudly designated as an institution “for the purpose of instruction of persons, both male and female, in the art of teaching the various branches that pertain to a good common school.”

By the time it became Eastern Washington College of Education in 1937, Eastern was already a fully accredited four-year degree-granting institution, offering majors in numerous subjects.

The campus grew rapidly in size and program offerings in the decades following World War II. In 1961, the name was again changed, this time to Eastern Washington State College. It was increasingly evident that the region needed professionals in many fields; in response, a wide range of undergraduate and graduate degree programs were added. Finally, in 1977, the name was changed to Eastern Washington University by the state legislature.

As a regional university, Eastern is charged with the special responsibility of meeting the undergraduate and graduate educational needs of the region’s people.

To that end, program areas have grown and been redefined as the needs of the Inland Northwest have grown and changed. Master’s programs have been added to meet the need for graduate-level education, and individual programs and schools have increasingly been granted accreditation by their respective oversight organizations as those programs and schools have grown and matured.

Today, Eastern students represent nearly every state in the union and more than 40 foreign countries. More than 100 different academic majors are available, offering students a wide variety of career-path options.

Nearly 600 full-time and adjunct faculty teach on the Cheney campus and at several locations throughout the state. Three-quarters of Eastern’s full-time faculty members hold doctorate degrees. With a low student-to-faculty ratio, Eastern continues to stress small classes, personalized instruction and individual attention.

Perhaps even more significant than Eastern’s steady advancement during the past 135 years is the university’s expanded regional role and its evolving goals, objectives and vision of its future.

In the past decade, Eastern Washington University has become a major force in the state and the Pacific Northwest, not only in the education of more than 12,000 students each year, but in the civic, cultural, scientific and economic development of the state and region.

GRADUATION WITH ACADEMIC HONORS

Undergraduate students who have demonstrated exceptional academic performance are honored in the commencement program listing.

Summa Cum Laude: Seniors who have a cumulative grade point average of 3.90-4.00-Gold Honors Cord.

Magna Cum Laude: Seniors who have a grade point average of 3.70-3.89-Silver Honors Cord.

Cum Laude: Seniors who have a grade point average of 3.50-3.69-Red and White Honors Cord.

University Honors: Seniors who completed special course work requirements through the Honors Program-Purple Honors Cord.

UNIVERSITY MACE

The tradition of a ceremonial mace for academic institutions goes back to medieval times. Adapted in form from the ancient battle weapon used by knights, the ceremonial mace symbolized the authority of regal personages, city or shire ruling bodies and chief officers of chartered institutions.

Originally representing vested authority during all official meetings, it eventually came to be connected mainly with formal ceremonies. In academic institutions, this is usually in conjunction with an academic procession, where the mace is carried at the head of the line of march or just before the platform party.

The form of the ceremonial mace has remained fairly consistent over the centuries. Design often reflects the period of creation, especially in the elaboration of ornamentation. Gold, silver and dark wood are traditional materials.

Eastern's mace, commissioned as a gift during the centennial year to the university by former and present members of the EWU Board of Trustees, was created by artist-craftsman Clifford Gaynard after a region-wide design competition. Its polished silver head in flowing cuplike form carries the university seal. The dark rosewood shaft with upper and medial gold-plated bosses is gently curved into the terminal silver cap at the bottom.

Although the modern design departs from the traditional straight and elaborately ornamented pattern, it retains a full effect of balance, dignity and decorum, while capturing the flowing lines typical of the eastern Washington landscape.

A permanent display case for the Eastern Washington University mace is located in the Office of the President.

ACADEMIC REGALIA

The regalia worn for formal academic ceremonies such as commencements are patterned after the gowns and hoods worn regularly in the Middle Ages by scholars for warmth in unheated buildings and as distinguishing dress denoting their place in society.

A great variety of designs and colors developed over the years in the costumes worn at different universities. Since 1895 in the United States, a uniform intercollegiate code of style and colors has been adhered to by most institutions.

In accordance with this code, most academic gowns are black, although some universities permit other solid colors. Occasionally, the robe color may indicate a professional distinction, such as deep purple for law or scarlet for ecclesiastical honors. Adaptations of the academic costume for high schools have sometimes used colors other than black for purely decorative purposes. Sometimes a distinguishing device on the robe or cap indicates an individual honor or a special occasion.

The baccalaureate gown is of simple cut with full, somewhat pointed sleeves. The front is closed and often no hood is worn with this gown. The mortar board head covering originated in ancient Greece, symbolizing the

commitment of the scholar to a life of building. It has either a plain black tassel or one of a color indicating the subject area of the degree. The custom of shifting the cap's tassel from right to left at the time of awarding the degree is used in lieu of investing each candidate with the bachelor's hood.

The master's gown is similar to the bachelor's gown, except that the sleeves are fuller, cut square with a half-circle at the bottom and sometimes worn with the arms through a horizontal slit at elbow level.

The doctoral robe is ampler in cut with a full bell-shaped sleeve, velvet panel edging in the front and three velvet stripes on each sleeve. The velvet trim may be black or in the color appropriate to the degree. The mortar board tassel for the doctorate is gold. Some American and many foreign universities use cap forms other than the mortar board, ranging from a soft velvet beret to more elaborate fringed styles, each of which has its own historical tradition.

Hoods worn over the gowns have a velvet edging, usually in a color indicating the specific degree and a lining which is partially turned out to show the colors of the college or university which granted the degree.

Hashim Akeel



Graduating today with a Bachelor of Science in Applied Developmental Psychology, Hashim hails from Saudi Arabia and came to EWU as a transfer student. During his time at Eastern, he held leadership roles with the International Student Association and Saudi Club, and served as a volunteer for Westwood Middle School in Spokane and Frontier Behavioral Health's First Call for Help crisis

hotline. One of his proudest accomplishments is publishing a book on socio-psychological norms of Arabic youth, which he reports was influenced by the life experiences he had during his time at EWU. Nancy Birch, PhD, joined the EWU College of Business in 1988 as an assistant professor. She has served as a professor of decision sciences since 1998 and chaired the Accounting and Information Systems Department from 2005 to 2009.

Birch received her BS in microbiology from the University of Arizona in 1975,

her MBA with emphasis in quantitative business analysis in 1981 and her PhD in applied statistics in 1988 from Arizona State University.

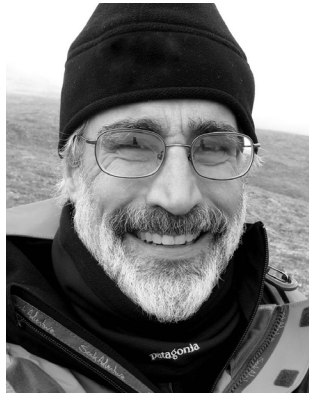
At EWU, she taught a variety of graduate and undergraduate courses, from introductory statistics to multivariate data analysis, experimental design and research methods. Birch received excellent student evaluation scores, all while maintaining a reputation as an instructor with high expectations for student learning and performance.

Her research focused on linear models, and cross-disciplinary research with applications of statistics to fields like health services, marketing and management. Birch was active in scholarly publication with more than 30 peer-reviewed publications. In addition, she had numerous academic conference proceedings and presentations.

In recognition of her teaching, research and service activities, Birch has received a number of awards. Among them, the 2002 College Research Excellence Award and the 2009 Research Excellence Award. Nominated by a student in 1998, she received the Who's Who Among America's Teachers Distinguished Educator award. In 2012, the Eta Phi Chapter of Alpha Kappa Psi, a professional business fraternity, awarded her the Distinguished Service Award for her lengthy service as faculty advisor.

Birch served on many committees at the department, college and university levels while at Eastern. She was active in curriculum development and revision. She developed three classes that are now part of the analytics majors, was instrumental in the development of the minor in data analytics and played a vital part in developing the majors in business analytics and data analytics.

John P. Buchanan



John Buchanan, PhD, began his career at EWU in 1984, and spent the past 35 years focusing his academic research and teaching on sedimentology, hydrogeology and geomorphology—but with a keen interest in all things geological. He additionally served as Director of the Environmental Science

Program for nine years, and was awarded the Burlington Northern Faculty Achievement Award in 1989 for recognition of distinguished achievement in teaching and scholarship. He's not only a registered professional geologist and hydrogeologist, but he also works as a consultant to both private companies and at the federal, state and local government levels. As an experienced expedition guide and naturalist since 2008, and a qualified Zodiac driver, Buchanan enjoys sharing his passion for outdoor exploration, as well as his personal experiences as an avid photographer, mountaineer, private pilot and amateur astronomer. FACULTY EMERITI RECOGNITION

Mary Ann Clute



Mary Ann Clute, PhD, began her career with Eastern Washington University in the School of Social Work as lecturer/special faculty in 2000 and was hired into a tenure-track line in 2008.

Clute has always worked to better herself as a social worker, researcher and educator. She has dedicated herself to refining and

updating her stellar abilities as a social worker and as a social work educator. Clute is worthy of this recognition for excellence in teaching, intellectual contributions and service to the university, college and the School of Social Work.

Throughout her career at Eastern, Clute has explored more interesting ways to engage students in learning and has served as a model for faculty by recognizing the key content in each course. Clute is known for using clear, focused assignments, instead of overwhelming students with complex, extensive assignments that go beyond the scope of the course.

Clute has made substantial contributions in social work approaches to disability and end-of-life care. She has extensive published works, presentations, trainings and projects on these topics. In service, Clute made substantial contributions to the founding and continuation of the Disability Studies Program and is an active participant on the Spokane County Developmental Disabilities Board. Clute is highly qualified for emeritus status and will continue her successful affiliation with Eastern Washington University, even as she retires as a tenured full professor.

Gary J. Krug

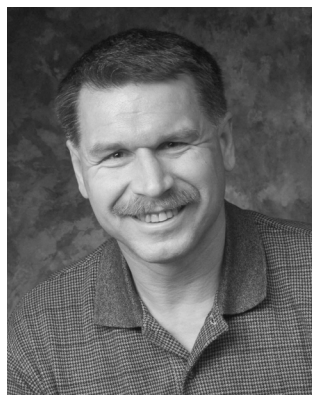


Gary Krug obtained his doctorate from the Institute for Communications Research, University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign, in 2012. He was hired at Eastern Washington University in 2002 and was promoted to full professor in 2012. Krug fulfilled his service to the university in a variety of ways. He has contributed his time

and knowledge tirelessly and generously to a number of vital bodies and initiatives taking place on campus, serving the university, college, department and community at large. He served as chair of the Department of Communication Studies for seven years – longer than any other faculty member in the department who served as chair. Krug served as both UFE president and the vice-president for labor management in the United Faculty of Eastern. Among his many time-intensive responsibilities were liaising with EWU administration on implementation and enforcement of the College of Business Administration, as well as working with EWU faculty in ensuring that the contract was fairly employed. Krug was a member of Undergraduate Affairs Council and Faculty Senate, and served on many other committees over the years. Krug has hosted two radio shows for the local station KYRX – “Eat the Press” and “Long Waves” – in which he shared his analysis of news and events in historical and cultural perspective. All these service contributions reflected Krug’s strong social position of a citizen. Krug was an engaging and dedicated teacher, and was respected by his students and colleagues. He taught numerous undergraduate and graduate classes at EWU, and was skilled in producing a classroom environment that was highly conducive to student learning. His enthusiasm was contagious when he shared his expertise in the areas of media and technology, political communication, global communications, integrated social science theory and methods, and cultural studies.

FACULTY EMERITI RECOGNITION

Romel W. Mackelprang



Romel Mackelprang, PhD, served as a faculty member in the School of Social Work for more than 30 years and was among the most accomplished members of the EWU community during his tenure. He came to Eastern in 1987, following more than ten years of full-time work in medical social work, rehabilitation and psychiatric services.

Mackelprang's scholarly accomplishments are numerous. He is recognized as a national leader in the area of disability and human services. He is the author of four academic textbooks on human services and disability and is currently completing a fifth textbook on human behavior in the social environment. He also authored more than 40 scholarly, peer-reviewed publications, most focusing on disability and human services and medical social work. In addition, Mackelprang has made more than 50 presentations at professional conferences and has served on editorial boards for multiple journals.

During his more than 30-year tenure at EWU, Mackelprang secured nearly \$2 million in grant funding to support a variety of educational and research endeavors. One of Mackelprang's lasting legacies at EWU is the establishment of the Disability Studies Program, for which he served as director for more than 15 years.

Mackelprang and his work have been recognized with many awards, including, the Lifetime Achievement Award for Service to the Disability Community from the Coalition of Responsible Disabled, a leadership award from the Washington State Department of Health for this work on the Governor's Advisory Council on HIV/AIDs, and an Outstanding Volunteer Service from the Spokane Public School District for his work related to diversity. The School of Social Work is proud of Mackelprang's contribution to the university and the community at large.

Doris M. Munson



Doris M. Munson holds an MLS from the University of Washington, a BS in animal science from Oregon State University and an AAS in computer information services from Portland Community College. Though Munson joined the library faculty at EWU as an assistant professor in 2003, she had been a librarian in higher education since 1989.

During her time at Eastern, Munson served as both Systems/Reference Librarian (2003-2016) and Access Services Librarian (2016-2019). She achieved the rank of professor in 2013. During the final phase of her career at EWU, Munson had supervisory responsibility for the JFK Library's circulation and interlibrary loan operations. She guided staff in those operational areas through a number of technical and operational changes.

Throughout her career, Munson was committed to service to the university. She served in a number of leadership roles, most notably as the president of the Faculty Organization during the 2010-11 academic year. She also served on multiple committees at EWU, including the Faculty Values Committee, Academic Systems Advisory Committee, Academic Computing Council and the Library Affairs Committee.

Munson focused her scholarship on the use and operation of library systems – the systems that manage and track library resources, and the systems that provide discoverability and access of those resources for the university community. She is recognized as a leader in her field and as an expert in operational aspects of the Integrated Library System employed by EWU and a number of other institutions. She has been a frequent presenter on the topic at national conferences. Munson was active in the Ex Libris Users of North American professional organization, and notably, co-authored the successful bid to bring the national conference to Spokane in 2018.

FACULTY EMERITI RECOGNITION

Charles V. Mutschler



Charles V. Mutschler, PhD, earned his doctorate in history from Washington State University in 1999, an MS in archives and records management from Western Washington University in 1992, and both an MA and BA in history from Eastern Washington University in 1981 and 1977 respectively. He began his career at Eastern in

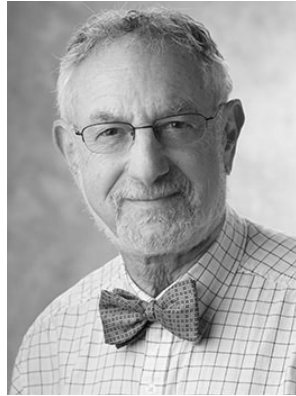
1978 as an archival assistant. He advanced to assistant archivist in 1983 and university archivist in 2001. He achieved the rank of professor in 2012. Mutschler died unexpectedly earlier this year. At the time of his passing, he was serving as Interim Dean of Libraries and Learning Commons.

Mutschler was an expert in the history of the Inland Northwest and the authority on EWU history. As the university archivist, he was responsible for managing, preserving and providing access to rare, fragile and one-of-a-kind documents, photographs, books and other materials of historical relevance to Eastern and the wider community. In addition to his faculty appointment in EWU's libraries, Mutschler was an adjunct faculty member in the history department, where he taught courses in cultural resource management and archives.

Over the course of his career, Mutschler wrote two books, *A Doctor Among the Oglala Sioux Tribe: The Letters of Robert H. Ruby, 1953-1954*, and *Wired for Success: The Butte, Anaconda & Pacific Railway, 1892-1985*. He also authored 12 articles and book chapters. He was a frequent event speaker on Inland Northwest history.

Mutschler had a strong record of service to the university and community. His recent university service included the Faculty Senate and the EWU Program Review Committee. He was also well known in the Cheney community, where he served, among other roles, on the board of the Cheney Environmental Association and as chair of the Cheney Historic Preservation Commission.

Henry-York Steiner



Dr. Henry-York Steiner is retiring after sixty-one years of college and university teaching, fifty of which have been here at Eastern Washington University. An alumnus of Grinnell College (B.A.), Yale University (M.A.) and the University of Oregon (Ph.D.), he joined Eastern's administration and faculty in 1968. As

Dean of Undergraduate Studies (1968-79), he helped create and nurture the programs now known as American Indian Studies, Africana Studies, Chicano Education, University Honors, and Environmental Studies. As an incredibly respected and popular professor, he has taught 20 different graduate and undergraduate courses ranging from composition to English and American literature to folklore, mythology, rhetoric, philosophy and religion, environmental studies, and recreation.

Hank Steiner is known to students, administrators, faculty, and many people in supporting roles over the decades for his intellect, compassion, and integrity. He has been a model and mentor to generations of students and faculty. One of his colleagues recently said: "When I grow up, I want to BE Hank Steiner."

Unfortunately, there is only one original. Fortunately, we have had the joy of learning with and from him. In addition, Henry-York Steiner has served 48 years on the 49 Degrees North Ski Patrol, and the National Ski Patrol System, as a patroller, administrator, instructor, and instructor trainer. His wife, Lori, is a recipient of an EWU Alumni Award. It is safe to say that Henry-York Steiner's contributions to our community and to so many individuals are greater than mere words can express.

TRUSTEES' MEDAL AWARD

The Trustee's Medal Award is the university's highest form of recognition for faculty achievement. Each year since 1978, the award has honored teaching excellence, significant contributions to scholarship and research,

and accomplishments in the development of academic programs and curriculums. The award consists of a silver medallion and a \$1,500 cash prize from the EWU Foundation.

Jacqueline (Jackie) R. Coomes, PhD

Throughout her nearly 20-years in the Department of Mathematics at EWU, Jackie Coomes has shown unwavering dedication to teaching, scholarship and service. To say students come first for Coomes would be an understatement.

"She has an inspiring way of encouraging every student and truly believes everybody has something in which they are an expert," writes Mathematics Education student Zoë Romero Becker. "Her guidance as a professor, club advisor, and mentor is priceless and Eastern Washington University is fortunate to have her spirit and expertise."

Students and faculty alike describe Coomes as an incredible mentor with a passion and a talent for both mathematics and teaching. She has a proven track record of going above and beyond, not only for students at the university, but also for primary and secondary students and teachers across the state, dedicating special attention to students' transitions from high school to college.

An Eastern alumna, Coomes earned her MS in Mathematics from the university in 1998 after graduating Cum Laude from the University of California, Davis with a BS in Mathematics. Upon her graduation from EWU, Coomes earned a doctorate from Washington State University while simultaneously working as a Mathematics Specialist in the EWU Department of Mathematics and the EWU TRiO Program.

Since her first days in the department, Coomes devoted immense energy to improve the condition of mathematics education in the state of Washington. Her development of academic programs and curriculums started with more than two dozen publications and continued with the development of practical programs to help students connect and succeed. Coomes championed the formation of the Mathematics

Education Club, which provides STEM students the resources they need to meet, study, plan events and tutor younger students.

A strong commitment to students and scholarship has inspired Coomes to secure more than \$4 million in external grant money—money used to equip the Mathematics Lab with new computers and software and add work study programs so EWU students can tutor K-12 math students. Her overwhelming financial achievements have helped EWU provide instructional material, add student/teaching programs, provide scholarships and expand tutoring resources.

Coomes' impressive grant work not only strengthens math education at Eastern, it strengthens programs across the state. She worked as project director for the Riverpoint Advanced Mathematics Partnership-Algebra, which provided professional development to mathematics teachers in ESD 101 preparing high school students for college-level math. She also partnered with The Office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI) for Higher Education and District Collaborations. In an unsolicited letter to the Department of Mathematics, OSPI praised Coomes' contributions to Washington State

Mathematics, writing, "this initiative could not have been accomplished without Jackie's vision and commitment in how to best support all students."

Coomes remembers graduates, knows where they are teaching, what they have been succeeding at and what they have been struggling with. This special relationship allows her to help former students while also learning from their experiences. She is building a far-reaching legacy of educating and mentoring generations of mathematics teachers.

The Distinguished Service Awards are given each year to recognize exemplary service and outstanding contributions to the university. Letters of nomination and support are reviewed by the University Medals and Awards Committee.



Carlos Muñoz
Administrative Exempt

In his capacity of academic advisor, Carlos Muñoz provides outstanding service for to EWU's McNair scholars, staff, faculty mentors and the TRIO community in the state of Washington. Throughout this time at Eastern and in his numerous roles, as a graduate student, PLUS Program

coordinator, Writers' Center responder, English lecturer and colleague on the McNair Program staff, he has exemplified the best EWU has to offer in student-centered service, as well as in campus collegiality.

In their nomination letter, Christina Torres García and Cynthia Dukich, director and assistant director of the McNair Scholar Program wrote, "Carlos Muñoz has fostered excellence in learning through quality academic programs such as a seminar and workshop to build students' scholarly identity. His ability to apply different pedagogical styles to student learning has given him the 'go to person' reputation. Talented as a writer, teacher, researcher and responder, he is often asked to teach classes, or perform other duties for students or the EWU campus community, and regardless of how many tasks he has already been assigned, he does whatever he can to rearrange his schedule to say 'yes.'"

In her nomination letter, Gail Forsgreen, assistant director of the Writers' Center, wrote, "Carlos is always researching innovative ways to reach the current student demographic. During his work at the Writers' Center, he is continually redefining and expanding our services to meet the needs of students, for example, developing materials for interacting and composing in multimodal platforms. Carlos spends hours of his own time creating materials that will attract students to learning. He is constantly researching best practices in teaching and learning, and creating and implementing new ideas. Carlos is a true collaborator and is eager to share his work with staff and students. He is approachable and knowledgeable, humble and always helpful. Carlos' contribution makes a lasting impression on the EWU students, staff and faculty, and has greatly affected our university for its betterment."

The award includes the Distinguished Service Award medallion and a check for \$1,000. These awards were presented at the University Family Thanksgiving reception in November 2018.

2018-2019 FRANCES B. HUSTON MEDALLION AWARDS

The Frances B. Huston Medallion Recognizes Graduating Seniors for Excellence in Academics, Leadership, and Service.

Frances Breitweg Huston was born in Vancouver, Washington, Aug. 13, 1912. She grew up in Portland, Oregon, and received her Bachelor of Arts degree from Reed College in 1931, and her Master of Arts in English Literature from the University of Washington (1947/1948). In 1955, Graham Dressler, PhD, professor of English at what was then Eastern Washington College of Education, offered Huston a position teaching English and English as a second language. Huston joined EWU's faculty in the fall of 1955 and taught until her retirement in academic year 1975/1976.

The Frances B. Huston Medallion Award was established in 1998 by a gift from Mary Ann Nelson, EWU professor of English emerita, as a tribute to Huston's lifelong commitment to education and a generosity to students that was quiet but ongoing. The medallion award program recognizes outstanding graduates and reflects Huston's compassion and respect for

what education can do for an individual and a community. This award is presented to only 20 graduating students each year.

Recipients of the Frances B. Huston Medallion Award will have established themselves as exceptionally capable individuals in both academic and extracurricular activities. The faculty and administration of Eastern Washington University acknowledge their great pride in the accomplishments of these students during their college experience and expect even greater accomplishments in the years that lie ahead.

To be eligible to receive the award, students must

- be graduating seniors;
- have demonstrated outstanding academic achievement with a minimum of a 3.75 GPA in their previous four quarters; and
- qualify for the award in one or more of the following areas: leadership, service to the university and/or service to the community.

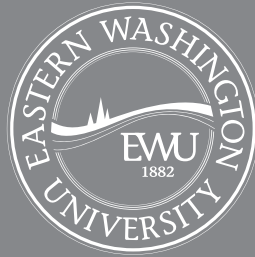
