


# Showalter Hall – 1<sup>st</sup> Floor

## Evacuation Routes




### Evacuation Safety Information.

- In case of fire, bomb threat, or other evacuation, close windows and doors and move to the nearest exit.
- Once outside, move away from the building and avoid blocking entrances and driveways.
- Have a location set to meet your class or department so that everyone can be accounted for.
- If anyone is missing or had to remain in the building, notify onsite authorities of their location (or presumed location if missing).
- Do not go back into the building until officials tell you it is safe.
- If someone is hurt and not in imminent danger, do not move them. Contact rescue personnel and tell them where the person is located.

## Evacuation Routes




### Evacuation Safety Information

- Never use the elevator in an emergency.
- If you are unable to evacuate during an emergency, call 911 and tell the operator where in the building you are located.
  - Try to alert someone who is able to evacuate to your location so they can let the emergency responders know you are inside.
  - In the event of a fire, move as far away from the fire as possible and close any doors between you and the flames.

### Evacuation Safety Information

- Never use the elevator in an emergency.
- The nearest AED is on the second floor.
- If you are unable to evacuate during an emergency, call 911 and tell the operator where in the building you are located.

  - In the event of a fire, move as far away from the fire as possible and close any doors between you and the flames.
