




2020 Employee Type Accident/Illness Incidents Totals by Quarter




2020 REPORTED ACCIDENT/ILLNESS INCIDENT BY EMPLOYEE TYPE





Departments with 2 or more Reported Accidents/Injuries, Illnesses - 2020




Count of Department ACCIDENT/INJURIES, ILLNESS REPORTED BY TOP 10 DEPARTMENTS 2012 TO 2020




Top 10 Reported Employee Accident/Injury, Illnesses by Injury Types 2012-2020




Total Reported Accident/Injuries, Illnesses by Body Location 2012-2020



TOP 10 REPORTED ACCIDENT/INJURY, ILLNESSES BY IMMEDIATE CAUSE 2012-2020





TOP 10 REPORTED ACCIDENT/INJURY, ILLNESSES BY ROOT CAUSE 2012-2020







Annual EWU Incident Injury/Illnesses Reporting compared to Employee Workforce 2012-2020






















Student/Visitor Reported Accident/Illnesses by Immediate Cause for 2020




Student/Visitors Reported Accident/Illnesses by Root Cause for 2020
