

**Memorandum of Understanding
Between
Eastern Washington University
and
The United Faculty of Eastern
Regarding
Semester Based Upper Division Military Science Courses**

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) sets forth the following agreement between the United Faculty of Eastern Washington University (the "Union" or "UFE") and Eastern Washington University (the "University" or "EWU").

Eastern Washington University and the United Faculty of Eastern agree that the establishment of semester-based upper division Military Science courses would be beneficial to Eastern Washington University students as it would enable students in semester-based programs to join Army ROTC, have access to the scholarship resources provided by the DOD, and pair their field of study with a career in the U.S. Army. Currently, this would open up opportunities for Dental Hygiene students and also students in the EWU Nursing Program when it begins Fall 2023.

Therefore, the parties agree to the following:

Noting that U.S. Army cadre members provide the instruction (with any support necessary from federal employees) for the Military Science courses and the U.S. Army Cadet Command provides Eastern Washington University with all academic course materials for the Military Science courses in a semester format, the courses described below shall be offered on a semester-basis.

- MLSC 301 Military Science & Tactics I - 3 credits
- MLSC 302 Military Science & Tactics II - 3 credits
- MLSC 303 Military Science & Tactics III – 3 credits
- MLSC 304 Military Science & Tactics Lab – 2 credits
- MLSC 307 Leadership Development and Assessment - 8 credits
- MLSC 399 Military Science Directed Study – Variable 1-5 credits
- MLSC 401 Military Science & Officership I – 3 credits
- MLSC 402 Military Science & Officership II – 3 credits
- MLSC 403 Military Science & Officership III – 3 credits
- MLSC 404 Military Science & Tactics IV Lab – 2 credits
- MLSC 496 Experimental Course – Variable 1-5 credits
- MLSC 499 Military Science Directed Study – 1 credit

This Agreement shall take effect upon execution and be approved and effective on the last date signed below.

All other terms of the current UFE-EWU CBA remain in effect.
