Eastern Washington University provides reasonable accommodation for employees who have a qualifying disability. Please complete this form and return it to the appropriate ADA representative listed below. **You are not required to disclose to your immediate supervisor the medical basis for a requested accommodation; however written documentation from a qualified health care provider is necessary when requesting disability accommodations, unless the disability is obvious. It is the employee's responsibility to see that their health care provider returns the required information to the individual/office listed below.** A medical examination may be required.

If more specific information is needed to respond to a request for accommodation, a Job Analysis for your position may be prepared. A completed copy of the Job Analysis will be shared with you and your health care provider.

Medical records are treated confidentially and are maintained separately from personnel/academic files.
