A template for Statement of Academic Purpose (SOAP)

This is simply a guide to help you formulate your ideas and thoughts. You have to pay attention to what the prompt is asking of you — which could be only a two-page statement, to breaking your writing response into discrete sections with specific questions. Usually, however, prompts ask generally the same thing. So, spend time writing a solid SOAP that you can parse and adjust accordingly.

- 1. Introduction paragraph
 - a. Your unique relationship to the research
 - b. This should have some background history of why you've chosen this area/major
- 2. Your current research paragraph
 - a. Definitely include your mentor's name!
 - b. This can include research you've done in the past
- 3. Your steps that you have taken to prepare for graduate school paragraph
 - a. Research conferences
 - b. McNair program
 - c. Internships
 - d. Research assistantships or volunteer work
- 4. A tie in with the university/professor
 - a. Drop their name(s)
 - b. How you have communicated phone call, skype session
 - c. Why this program/scholarship/internship is a good fit for you
- 5. Conclusion paragraph
 - a. Future research you intend to do
 - b. The impact this will have on the community
 - c. Essentially, what you see yourself doing in five years
