Thanks for the email Shauna.

Athletics was awarded money to cover student compensation for 2016-17. The amount we requested and were awarded was \$250,000. We actually wrote about this specifically in our Funding Proposal for 2017-18 so we pulled that information for you:

Student Compensation: \$250,000 - \$215,000 in Student Wages; \$35,000 in Graduate Assistantships

Final numbers for 2015-16 had the final student compensation amount being \$283,069.17, of which \$251,343.75 was spent on student wages & \$31,725.42 in graduate assistantships awarded. Based on the activity thus far in 2016-17, and taking into account three additional home football games in December and an increase the minimum wage to \$11.00/hour on 1/1/17, we are projecting student compensation numbers to be about \$325,000 for this year. This is an estimated \$75,000 more than what was requested for this budget year.

Taking all of this into consideration, we would argue the majority of the \$75,000 increase to \$325,000 had more to do with the fact we had more opportunities to employ students with some additional home athletic contests in 2016-17 (three more football games and quite a few more home basketball games on average) than it would from an increase in the minimum wage. If I were to put a number on it, I would say about \$65,000 would be for this reason and the minimum wage increase is probably causing about \$10,000 of this shortfall. I don't see anywhere in our budget where I can cover this from at this time as well.

Based on all of this information, our request to you would be for \$10,000 to cover these expenses. If it can't be that amount, I know any additional funding would help us to alleviate our current shortfall in this area.
