#### THE STATE CONTINUES TO LOOK FOR WAYS TO SUPPORT OUR VETERANS AND MILITARY

There are several Bills working their way through the State House and Senate that if passed will have an impact on our military and veterans.

HB 1011—Removing the one-year waiting period for veterans or active members of the military for purposes of eligibility for resident tuition. This will have an impact on allowing service members who are not Washington state residents


to pay resident tuition.

**HB** I 109—Requiring institutions of higher education that offer an early course registration period to provide early registration for eligible veterans and national guard members.

SB 5343—Concerning the rights of higher education students involved in military service. This will help protect those National Guard or Reserve members who are called up for less

than 30 day. Colleges and Universities must accommodate these students in regards to academic progress and completion of course work.

The VRC will keep you updated on when these bills are approved and the impact on our student veterans at EWU.





We distributed close to \$5500 in Winter Quarter to off set costs of child care for our student veterans. We have just over \$4100 remaining in the grant to assist with child care cost for Spring Quarter. Stop by the VRC to enroll for this grant.
