Upon entering the Let's Talk Zoom meeting, you will initially reside within a waiting room, and will be greeted by your counselor when they become available (you will not be visible to other students waiting or being served). The Let's Talk counselor will listen closely to your concerns and provide support, perspective, and suggestions for resources when indicated.

Let's Talk is different from ongoing counseling, which usually consists of weekly or bi-weekly 45-50 minute sessions. Let's Talk is not formal therapy or counseling: It is a drop-in service where students can engage in a brief, informal, 15-20 minute consultation with a counselor.
