What is the equity-based school practices requirement in Washington state?

- All Washington state teachers must complete 15 clock hours, or the equivalent for certificate renewal. Administrators must complete 10 clock hours, or the equivalent.
- The equity certificate renewal requirements must be met for renewal applications submitted beginning July 1, 2023. The requirements went into effect as of June 30, 2024, meaning that now certificates not meeting this requirement will expire.
